Class 523B was the sister class of 523A, however, this class started 3 weeks later and finished 3 weeks earlier than 523A. The reason for this was that Bravo was comprised of reserves who only had a 6 month active obligation, before beginning their drilling reserve status. By the time they had completed boot camp and assembled at Lakehurst, they only had 13 weeks of their 6 month active obligated service left. In reality Class 523B only missed the math/physics review, and Airman instruction at the beginning and Lab at the end of the school.
