The system is scheduled to become operational in 1987.

"In the last 85 years we have gone from using lead lines to lasers for survey work. To do this job you must know math, physics, and the basic tenets of surveying. You must keep up with all the new technology. There's no other job like it," she says.

She adds that it's gratifying to see more women showing up in maledominated professions such as her own.

"These days there is much more emphasis on what a woman can do rather than what someone thinks she should do. Because of this we are seeing—and will continue to see increasingly I think—a lot more qualified women in scientific and technical professional fields than in the past."
